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Exciting News: Introducing Visualcare

As of September 1st, we've transitioned all our services to our new system, **Visualcare**. You'll notice a few changes, like the care team no longer signing communication sheets and your statements looking different, but rest assured your services remain the same.

St Louis is committed to continually improving our services, Visualcare allows us to operate more efficiently and effectively meet our clients' needs. We're here to answer any questions you have, thank you for your understanding as we make this transition!

Updated Minimum Service Time

After a recent review of our services, we have decided to make a small change that will enhance both the quality of care and the sustainability of our services. Starting November 1, 2024, all our care visits will have a minimum duration of one hour. By moving to a one-hour minimum for each visit, we can:

- Provide you with more comprehensive, unhurried care, ensuring that all your needs are fully met without feeling rushed.
- Assist you with a wider range of tasks and provide additional support during each visit, helping you more effectively in your day-to-day life, and assist you in meeting your goals.
- Ensure our services remain financially sustainable, allowing us to continue offering high-quality care to you and all of our clients in the long term.

This change will also help us support our staff more effectively, so they have the time and resources they need to deliver the best care possible. If you currently have any services with St Louis staff that is less than one hour (excluding nursing and allied health) these will remain unchanged for now. However, **from the 1st of November** 2024, all requests for new services will be for a minimum of one hour.

We encourage you speak with your coordinator on 8332 0950, about increasing any existing services that are less than an hour and updating your Care and Support plan to include more supports in this time.

Note from the Rostering Team

At St Louis, we believe that having a small, dedicated team of care workers enhances the care and support provided to our clients. Our rostering team strive to ensure all our clients' services are arranged.

We kindly ask that you allow a 15-minute window before and after your scheduled services as we adjust to the new system. Should there be any changes to your care staff, we will notify you immediately.
